IT'S TICK SEASON AGAIN...

As deer ticks become more prevalent, your dog is more likely to develop an infection. The most common signs of Lyme disease include:

- Lameness
- Fever
- Swollen Joints
- Kidney Failure
- Anorexia
- Not acting like him/herself

Heartworm is another major problem for pets this time of year. The most common signs of infection related to heartworm include:

- Mild, persistent cough
- Reluctance to move or exercise

- Tiredness after moderate exercise
- Reduced appetite
- Weight loss
